I. EVALUATION OF FELLOWSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

- A.** All consultant staff members must be bona fide members of the Philippine Obstetrical and Gynecological Society (POGS) and the Philippine Society of Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology (PSUOG).
- B.** The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology must be accredited as Level II-A by the Philippine Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology (PBOG).
- C.** The training program must have a core curriculum in the format prescribed by the PSUOG.
- D.** The Section of Ultrasound must be organized with a minimum of five (5) consultant staff with 5 years experience as trainer in the same institution.

II. PHYSICAL PLAN

A. Physical set up

1. Ultrasound complex composed of a scanning room, waiting room, changing room and toilet, Sonologists' office
2. Emergency cart or access to emergency service

B. Ultrasound machines

1. At least two (2) ultrasound machines with Doppler and 3D/4D capabilities

C. Generation of reports

1. Completely computerized reports
2. Consent forms

D. Storage of Ultrasound data

1. Hard copies
2. Digital Files
3. Archiving of data

E. Library facilities

1. Original standard textbooks in Obstetrics and Gynecology (OB-GYN) and OB-GYN ultrasound (Callen, PSUOG Doppler book, PSUOG standardization 2017)
2. Teaching learning materials
3. Image Gallery
4. Subscription to Ultrasound in OB-GYN Journal (White journal)
5. Internet access to ISUOG website and ISUOG journals



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III. TEACHING STAFF

- A. Must be Fellows in good standing of POGS and PSUOG.
- B. Section of Ultrasound must be composed of a minimum of five (5) certified Fellows of PSUOG with a minimum of 5 years experience as Trainers in the OB GYN Department ultrasound clinic of the said institution.
- C. Should have a minimum of one (1) trainer per two (2) trainees (Ratio of 1:2)
- D. Must have acquired Certification of Good Clinical Practice.
- E. Continuing Medical Education (CME) of Consultants are required and are being monitored.
- F. Attendance of Section Chief and/or Training Officer to Fellows training updates, trainings and community service sponsored by PSUOG.

V. TRAINEES

- A. *Should be Full Diplomates (part 1 and 2 passers of the POGS certifying examination)*

B. Research output

1. With Certificate of Good Clinical Practice
2. Research protocol approved by the Institutional Review Board (IRB) or at the very least, approved by the Research Committee of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology of the respective training hospital
3. Individualized GANT Chart of Progress for every Fellow in training
4. Final research paper and interesting case report (submitted within 3 months from the last day of training period)



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C. Patient load

1. Minimum of 5 patients/day/trainee
2. Monthly census for reference and record purposes

D. Logbook Requirements

1. Individual logbooks of all patients scanned classified according to procedure to include: date, Case Number/Patient ID No., age, sonologic diagnosis, supervising Consultant and obstetrical outcome (birth weight, anomalies) and for gynecologic ultrasound, to include the histopathologic results.
2. Section's annual census as to number of procedures done

- B. Updated list of current Fellows in training, indicating the date they started training indicating institution where they had their residency training,
- C. Updated list of all Fellow graduates, year graduated, PSUOG certification status and current place of practice
- D. Updated list of Fellow graduates who failed or did not take the PSUOG certification exams
- E. Updated list of conferences attended by trainers and certification of further OB-GYN ultrasound - related workshops or training
