VOTING INSTRUCTIONS

Election Day will be on Friday, December 1, 2023, via online voting. It will start at 1:00 p.m. and close at exactly 5:00 p.m.

Only members of GOOD STANDING, with updated membership status and settled annual dues as of October 31, 2023, shall be allowed to vote.

The electoral process shall use an electronic voting system. You must vote for exactly SEVEN (7) candidates to validate your ballot.

HOW TO VOTE

1. Click the link or scan the QR Code
psuog2023.vs-elections.com



2. Login using your PRC number.
3. Read the voting instructions. If you encounter problems during the online voting process, send your name, PRC number, and report the predicament to the number and the email stated on your screen.
4. Choose seven (7) among the candidates. Then review your selections, as you can no longer go back after clicking submit. Finally, click SUBMIT to cast your vote.

5. The Confirmation page will state that your ballot has been successfully submitted and counted.
6. Click LOG-OUT.
